Dear Pastors, Prayer Partners, Family & Friends,

We find it hard to believe that this will be our last letter from the states and that our furlough is coming to an end. We had planned to fly back to Wales on April 14th, but have extended our stay until May 4th so that Kevin can perform the wedding of our oldest son, Troy, to Kayla Wilkins on May 1st! We so appreciate Troy and Kayla working it out so that we could attend their wedding and ask that you keep them in your prayers as they approach this important time in their lives.

January and February were very busy and we were blessed to be in quite a few of our supporting churches here in the Arizona area. Several of those were Missions Conferences and we have to say that we were spoiled rotten! As we mentioned in our last letter, we also had the privilege of attending a Biblical Counseling Training Conference which was amazing! We were so challenged and encouraged by the information and tools that we received and are excited to take what we've learned and apply it to ourselves, our marriage, our parenting, and in our ministry there in Wales.

On the 5th of March we head to California and will be in two week-long Missions Conferences back to back! We will then head to Lee's Summit, MO, where we have been basing out of, and will begin to get things ready for our trip back to Wales. While in Lee's Summit, we will also have the opportunity to speak and share our ministry in Wales at a Christian Academy. During the month of April we will be in two churches in Texas, our sending church in Springfield, MO, two churches in Michigan, and one church in Ohio. Some friends that we recently got reacquainted with have made it possible for us to also visit the Creation Science Museum while we are in the Ohio area! We are so excited about this and know that our time there will be very helpful as we speak and minister in Wales because of the great influence of Darwinism there.

We have so enjoyed our time with each of you this past year that were able to have us in and share what God has been doing in Wales, and more specifically, the village of Llanfairfechan. We have been encouraged, challenged, and equipped to go back and minister more effectively. Our hearts are full and we are anxious to get back home and to the ministry God has for us. Please pray that God will give us wisdom, discernment, direction, and guidance as we return to Wales in May. It is our desire to see God glorified through the ministry there and for those who claim to be Christians to grow and be strengthened in their walk with the Lord so that others will see Christ in them and be drawn to Him! We couldn't do it without you and are so grateful for your faithful support in prayers and finances!
